# The Hounds Hangout Ltd Terms & Conditions

#### 1. Vaccinations & Health

- All dogs attending must be vaccinated for Lepto, Parvovirus & Canine Cough.
- Vaccinations must be kept up to date whilst your dog attends daycare. A stand down period may be required if
  vaccinations are overdue or lapse. It is the owner's responsibility to keep vaccinations up to date whilst the dog is
  in attendance, yearly proof will be required upon request.
- All dogs must be free from any infectious illness or conditions that could potentially jeopardise other K9 members.
- If your dog is unwell or has an injury, we ask that they do not attend daycare until they are back to full health. In some cases, we will require vet approval to ensure it is safe for your dog to return.
- Owners must regularly check their dog's health and wellbeing. Please inspect your dog's eyes, ears, paws, skin & joints for any sign of discomfort or irritation. Dogs can share coughs, sniffles, eye infections and more The Hounds Hangout staff may turn away or send home any dog, at any time, who is believed to be unwell, injured or not currently fit for daycare.
- Dogs are not able to attend daycare with stitches/staples, an Elizabethan collar or bandages.
- All dogs attending daycare over the age of 8 months old, must be neutered/spayed. Females can not attend
  daycare whilst in season and may need to remain away for a few weeks following.
- Flea and worm treatments must be kept up to date.
- Puppies can begin daycare from 16 weeks old subject to vaccination status.
- If your dog is fed in the morning, please feed at least one hour before arriving at daycare. This allows the food to digest before exercise.

#### 2. Behaviour - Safety - Illness/Injuries

- Your dog must be generally well socialised with other dogs, and comfortable around humans to attend daycare.
   We may recommend further assistance or training if we believe The Hounds Hangout is not a suitable option for your dog. Your dog's mental wellbeing, happiness & safety is our priority in daycare.
- Certain behaviour will not be accepted or tolerated. This will be discussed with owners and may lead to the dog being denied service.
- Whilst your dog is on the premises & in our care, you authorise The Hounds Hangout Ltd to do whatever they
  deem necessary for the safety, management, health & wellbeing of your dog.
- You understand and accept any potential risks involved, including but not limited to, any injuries or illness that
  may occur whilst your dog is in attendance and you agree The Hounds Hangout Dog Daycare Ltd, is not liable for
  any vet bills or expense, resulting from any injury or illness beyond our control.
- In an emergency, if you, or the emergency contact person is unavailable, you authorise The Hounds Hangout staff
  to do whatever they deem necessary for the safety, health and wellbeing of your dog and you agree to assume full
  financial responsibility for any & all expenses incurred.

#### 3. Payments & Daycare Rates

- Payments can be made online or in reception. We do not accept cheques. Please note: There is a surcharge for all credit card payments. Services & Pre-Paid concessions must be paid on the day your dog attends or in advance.
- Daycare Rates <u>Daycare \$40 per day, per dog:</u> One dog attending one or two days per week or two dogs with
  the same owner attending one day per week <u>Daycare \$38 per day, per dog:</u> One dog attending three or more
  days per week or two dogs with the same owner attending at least two or more days per week <u>Purchase an 8</u>
  visit Pre-Paid concession & the 9th visit is FREE Pre-Paid concessions must be paid in advance or on
  the day your dog attends.

#### 5. General

- The Hounds Hangout has the right to refuse service to any dog or owner at any time and for any reason.
- Drop offs are strictly between 7.30am & 9.30am Please wait outside or in your car before 7.30am. Dogs arriving
  after 9.30am may be turned away.
- All dogs must arrive with a suitable collar and on a lead.
- On your dog's first day (Induction Day) you must arrive at 7am & be available by phone throughout the day –
   Arriving later than 7:10am may result in rescheduling the Induction.
- No owner or persons associated with the dog may enter the daycare playrooms unattended or without the permission from a staff member.
- Opening hours are Monday to Friday 7:30am to 6pm. (We are closed every public holiday and the Christmas/New vear weeks each year).
- You understand in failure to collect your dog by 6pm there will be an extra charge of \$15 for every 15 minutes you
  are late. If your dog is not collected by 7pm and we are unable to contact you, The Hounds Hangout staff will take
  it upon themselves to make arrangements for overnight care at your expense of an additional \$90 \$200 per dog.
- The Hounds Hangout may use any photos or video footage taken, for our website, social media or marketing purposes. *Please ensure you discuss this with us if you prefer not to have your dog included in this.*
- Please ensure we have correct & current contact information at all times. Under no circumstances will we share your personal information unless authorised by you.
- For dogs requiring lunch, these are fed between 12 & 12.30pm Please do not bring lunch for your dog if they do not normally eat lunch Lunch containers must be clearly named and collected upon pickup.
- All dogs must attend at least once per week and on their set & agreed day/s of attendance. Please be aware your
  dog may need to move playgroups for suitability If the correct group is at capacity we may require your dog to be
  placed on our waitlist.
- Please notify us as soon as possible if your dog will be absent from daycare. You can phone the landline (leave a voice message) or send us an email. Alternatively if you would like your dog to attend as an extra, please contact us in advance to ensure we have a spot available (Please note not all dogs are suitable to attend as extras in an unfamiliar playgroup).
- The Hounds Hangout Ltd reserves the right to change these terms and conditions or daycare prices from time to time at its discretion, with notice via newsletter or email.

## Induction & Assessment - First Day

All dogs attending The Hounds Hangout Dog Daycare undergo an Induction assessment which takes place on the first morning of attendance and throughout their first day with us. It is designed to evaluate your dog's social temperament and to ensure they will feel comfortable in the off-lead 'group' environment. We may assess new dogs for the first 3-5 visits before deeming them suitable for daycare.

- On your dog's first day, you must arrive at 7am Arriving later than 7:10am may result in rescheduling your dog's Induction/first day
- An owner or caregiver must be available by phone throughout the day for any necessary questions or early pickup
- Dogs need to arrive with a collar and on-lead (no spiked collars please!)
- If your dog/puppy requires lunch, please bring this with you in a named container. Please collect your container at the end of the day
- The Induction fee is a one-off cost of \$15 (excluding the daycare fee)
- For safety reasons, owners are required to leave before existing daycare dogs turn up from 7:30am

Arriving early allows The Hounds Hangout staff time to assess and bond with your dog one on one, this also gives him/her a relaxed opportunity to 'sniff out' the daycare premises where they will be spending their day. Being the first to arrive also allows your dog to meet the existing dogs one by one as they turn up, easing your dog into discovering new friends and their most suited playgroup.

#### During the Induction your dog will be evaluated for...

- Comfort level within the daycare environment
- Temperament & social skills, Any issues with aggression, resource guarding, anxieties, stress, excessive barking

Remember daycare and the group environment is not suitable for every dog. If we believe your dog will not settle into daycare comfortably, please do not take offence. This does NOT mean you have a 'bad' dog. We are simply ensuring the well-being and safety of all dogs attending including yours. We realise some dogs are better suited and happier in alternative environments and can recommend other suitable options if needed.
